We are deep into the dog days of summer. but Local 195's officers and staff continue to work on behalf of the membership. In particular, we are continuing to represent, to advocate in the legislative and legal arenas, and to fight back against attacks on our union directly. Sadly, it has come to our attention that anti union scammers are contacting public sector workers throughout our State with false and misleading information about the values of their union. Local 195 members and other union

members alike are being targeted by this scam. Don't fall for their misleading attacks.

OUR UNION is OUR STRENGTH. Just one percent of Local 195 members salaries go toward union dues. These are among the lowest dues of any labor union. In return, members reap huge benefits negotiated by Local 195. Some of these recently achieved benefits specific to Local 195 members include:

- 8% pay increases over four years from October 2019 to July 2022;
- Wage bonus for employees earning less than \$41,400 annually;
- \$550 clothing maintenance allowance for those that qualify;

- Yearly medical premium savings between \$346 to \$1576.

Those are only a few of the many benefits that your union delivers.
